The 2nd Annual *Pacific Northwest Western & Wildlife Arts Show* once again will take place at the Enumclaw Expo Center (formerly the King's County Expo Center) in the city of Enumclaw. Located 35 minutes southeast of Seattle this show was developed to replace the Pac Rim Wildlife Arts Show that ceased operations over six years ago in Tacoma, WA.

The 2007 was promising with 15 exhibitors and sales ranging from several hundred dollars for original paintings and prints to nearly \$5,000 for a single bronze sculpture. The promoter likes the Expo Center and location of Enumclaw. It is their hope visitor attendance, art sales improve each year as the company is dedicated to invest the time and expense to make this a successful show.

The 2009 Featured Artist is wildlife painter Pamela Stoehsler. Pamela also participated in the 2008 show and is once again looking forward to coming to Enumclaw. Admission to this show is free to the public. Exhibitors will begin setting up their booths on Friday, June 12 and the show runs between 10-5 on Saturday and 10-4 on Sunday. A reception is planned for Saturday evening between 5-7 pm with 25% of proceeds donated to the conservation group Snow Leopard Trust (www.snowleopard.org).
